2.4 PLAY MODE SETTING

If you find that the picture cannot expand, is rolling or is colorless, please adjust the PAL/NTSC.

DVD discs can support a picture in different proportions. Depending on the DVD disc, you may be able to modify the picture size of your TV screen. Press the SETUP key to get to General Set up. Press the PLAY key, then use the directional keys to select TV Mode. Press the left arrow key, to select Normal/Full, Normal/Letterbox or Widescreen according to your needs. To save press Play. Certain DVD discs cannot be modified.


3. BASIC OPERATION

Prior to play, make sure to complete the following preparatory operations.



4.13 ZOOM

The picture may be enlarged by up to 4 times to facilitate you to enjoy a particular action or still picture. Press this button 6 times, the zoom scales will be 2x, 3x, 4x, 1/2,1/3 and 1/4 respectively. Pressing the button once again will return to normal play status.

4.14 L/R

When play DVD, SVCD the display shows Aud1, Aud2 and no lead Sing. When play VCD disc it shows left lead sing, right lead sing and no lead sing.

4.15 VOLUME AND MUTE

Press the VOL+ key to increase volume, Press VOL- key to decrease volume.

Press the MUTE key to silence volume, press again to regain volume.

4.16 PROGRAM

While a disc is playing, press the PROG key on the remote to enter PROGRAM status. Enter the track numbers desired (i.e.2,4,6,8) then press the PLAY button to start.

To exit the programmed play mode, simply press the <PROG> key than press <Direction> key to Exit

4.17 SLOW

Press the SLOW button repeatedly to watch a DVD at 2X, 4X or 8X the slower forward or backward speed.

6. OPERATION OF MP3 MPEG4 FUNCTION

MP3 is an audio compression mode using Level 3 of the international standard MPEG, whereby sound signal is compressed in a rate of 12:1. A MP3 disc can record music for play of over 600 minutes or record over 170 songs, rivaling CDs in sound quality.

Divx-MPEG4 is a video encode using the international standard MPEG4 and audio using MP3 format.

To play a MP3 or MPEG4 disc

Files Menu of MP3 or MPEG4 play

When playing a MP3 disc, 2 files menus can be selected by pressing PROG key: File list, Folder.

1. FILE LIST

It may select the files to be played by pressing UP DOWN arrow key combining with ENTER key, or using number keys and ENTER key to select directly. If the number input is out of the music number, "CURRENT TRACK NUMBER" will display on screen.

2. Folder

Display menu first then press up down, left right arrow and ENTER key to select subdirectory and content.

7.JPEG

JPEG adopts the most efficient compression and is widely used as storage for flattened formatted pictures. Even if a picture is compress 15-20 times, it still retains a good quality. It is supported by most picture processing software, has small data and is easy to use. This machine can read JPEG formatted picture CD discs.

Press revelant number key to select picture display.

- 1.Put in disc correctly, the machine begins to search disc information.
- 2. Press number key to select picture.
- 3. It's efficient only in present picture when press number key.

Select to play by menu

8. TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE

For your convenience, we have enlisted some points to help solve problems you might encounter while using DVD player.

No Sound

- Make sure the good connection between player and other appliances such as power amplifier or TV.
- Make sure the right operation on TV and power amplifier.
- None of the functions are working.

No picture

- Make sure the good connection between player and other appliances such as TV.
- Make sure TV works on well.

Disc does not play

- Make sure the disc is loaded correctly (label side is facing up on the disc tray).
- Make sure the disc is clear.

Remote controller does not work

- Move the obstacle between player and remote controller away.
- Point the remote controller at the remote control sensor.
- Check the battery.
- Make sure the maximum distance is not exceeded.

Picture dividing

- Make sure the disc is clear and no any scratch on it.
- For the player is controlled by microcomputer, if encountering problem, switch off the power first, and switch on again in a few second, by then if no mistake notice is displayed, the player could work well.

9. DISC PROTECTION

Protection

- a. When loading or removing the discs, always hold them by the center and edge.
- b. Do not stick or write anything on the surface. Protect discs against any fingerprint.

Cleaning

Wipe the discs from time to time using a soft cloth. Always wipe from the center toward the edge.

Storage

- a. Never warp the discs. During non-use periods, store them in their cases, which should be kept vertically. Do not expose discs to high temperature, dampness or extremely low temperature, or else it may cause damage to the discs
 - b. Do not expose discs to direct sunlight.
